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The museum is housed within a Grade II listed Scheduled Monument made from Portland stone and glazed bricks and is located at the Kempton Park Water Treatment Works.

Located near to Sunbury-on-Thames in South West London and operated by Thames Water, this site continues to supply water to London to this day.



The mighty triple-expansion steam engines and the turbine engines, along with their water pumps and other machinery have been restored and preserved since 1995 by volunteers of the Kempton Great Engines Trust.

The museum opens for about eight weekends each year when 'The Sir William Prescott Engine' can be seen in action. Full details are on our website: <https://kemptonsteam.org>

Kempton Steam Museum is the home of the world's largest working triple-expansion steam engine known as 'The Sir William Prescott Engine'. The engine sits alongside two steam turbines and opposite an identical twin called 'The Lady Bessie Prescott Engine,' which is currently being restored.

The machines are as high as four stacked double-decker buses and closely resemble those used in the steamship RMS Titanic. The two triple-expansion engines and steam turbines pumped vast volumes of London's water supply from 1929 until 1980 when electrically driven pumps in an adjacent building superseded them.
