Important Information and reminders

Please note, all **class assemblies** this year will be held on a **Monday at 2:45pm.**

In the mornings, all children from Years 1 to 6 will enter the school from 8:45am and head to class for their soft starts. Reception children head to your classroom doors for 8:45am.

We will be continuing with OPAL, so make sure your children have the correct clothes for the weather!

Our new absence procedures are:

- We require proof for all absences, in order to authorise them
- If attendance drops, you will be called in to meet your child's teacher and Year Leader
- If there is no improvement, you will meet the Headteacher and school will initiate an Early Help Assessment and Plan (EHAP), in association with Children's Social Care
- We will be fining for all holidays, and all incidences of persistent absenteeism. New government guidelines require us to fine for 10 unauthorised missed sessions (5 days) in any 10-week period
- Teachers will give you the work your child missed, which must be completed and returned (for unauthorised absences)
- For families with low attendance, we will conduct unannounced home visits
- Time off for playing in sports events, modelling, TV work etc will only be authorised where attendance is at or above 96%

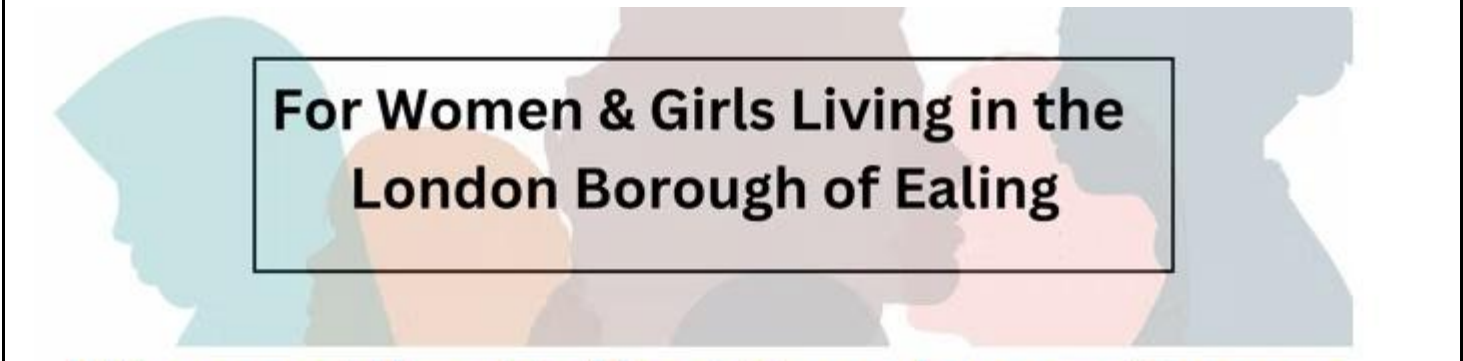
